



## Winter Pictionary

### Description

## Description

Students work together on teams in this winter-themed pictionary activity.

## Supplies

- Blackboard and chalk or whiteboard and dry erase markers
- Slips of paper with a different winter items/objects on each one (example list found on last page)
- Timer

## How to Play

1. Download and cut out the Winter Pictionary slips in the Downloads and Links section below.
2. Divide students into two teams.
3. Team 1 sends up their first player, who picks a slip of paper, reads it, and hands it to the leader.
4. Start the timer. The first player draws their item from their slip on the board while Team 1 guesses.
5. If Team 1 guesses correctly before the timer runs out they get two points. If Team 1 does not guess correctly, Team 2 gets one guess. If they guess correctly, they earn one point.
6. This continues switching up which team is drawing/guessing. Play until the time is up or until all slips of paper have been used.

## Activity Prompts for Reflection

- What is an emotion someone else in the group felt during this activity? Why?
- How do you think the other team felt during this competition?
- How did you show the person drawing that you were listening to them?

- When you were the drawer what emotions do you think your teammates felt?

## Other Ways to Play

- At the beginning have students write winter words on slips of paper, shuffle them up, and use these for the game.
- Help younger students by whispering the winter word into their ear when it's their turn to draw.
- Once all the slips have been used, start over with the slips and have students act out what is written on the slips of paper.

## Additional Notes

- Decide how long to make the timer based on the age of your students.
